

AUDI EDUCATION PARTNERSHIP (AEP)

Dunwoody College offers the Audi Education Partnership (AEP) program as an online, add-on credential for students enrolled in the College's Automotive Service, Mopar Career Automotive, or Honda Professional Auto Career Training programs. The program was specifically intended for students who are already working at an Audi dealership or would like to work at one.

During the program, students will have access to Audi Web Based Training (WBT) through Audi's Certification Resource Center (CRC) Access, which provides foundational training on engines, transmissions, brakes, and electrical systems.

Students complete Audi's online training modules on their own time. Access to the training modules is available 24/7 at no additional cost to the student. Training progress is monitored by the Dunwoody Audi Coordinator. Courses must be completed in a timely manner to remain active in the program.

Training credentials are awarded directly from Audi and are recognized nationwide at any Audi Dealership. Students who complete the program will be prepared for careers as an Audi Maintenance and Light Repair (MLR) certified technician.

Upon completion of the certificate, students are able to take additional courses and training through Audi so they may begin Audi's Fast Track program, which is required to become a certified Audi Service Technician 1.
