

# Facilities Service Management

## The Career

Facilities Service Managers are needed in different types of businesses at many different levels. Examples are: apartment buildings; manufacturing plants; schools; hospitals; retail facilities etc. Facilities Service Managers will manage and direct the maintenance, service and repair of a building's maintenance, including the heating and air conditioning systems, electrical systems, communications systems along with environmental and safety compliance, grounds maintenance, custodial support, cafeteria support and others such as building efficiency, usable space, swimming pool maintenance, security systems, etc.

## The Program

The Facilities Service Management Certificate is designed to give individuals skills and training as a Facilities Service Manager. It is designed to train you in the understanding of: drawings and specifications for commercial structures; environmental Health and Safety rules and regulations; training in the operation, servicing, maintenance and repair of Heating, Ventilating, Air conditioning, and boilers systems; electrical and telecommunications systems; and training in the use of an Oxyacetylene torch for cutting and welding. This program also prepares the students for certification testing in three areas; Boilers-Special, CFC (Chlorofluorocarbon) and CPO (Certified Pool Operator).

## Program Length

Graduates of this four-quarter program earn a certificate (28 credits).

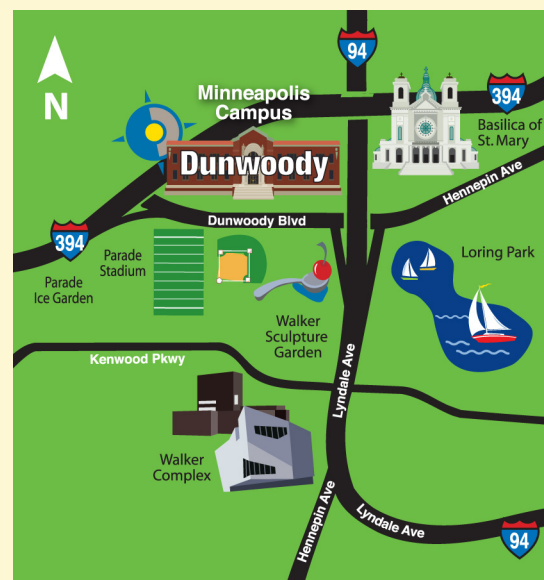
