Charlie Westling is the CEO of Computype, a leading global provider of automatic identification, barcode and RFID labeling solutions for the healthcare and industrial markets.

During the first part of his career, Westling was an investment banker assisting technology companies in raising capital and growing their businesses through mergers and acquisitions. Seeking a new challenge, he transitioned industries and became the President and CEO of Datalink Corporation; a publicly traded IT systems integrator and solutions provider of data center technologies. Joining Computype as CEO in 2010, Westling's primary objective has involved leading the transition from first to second-generation family ownership, while simultaneously accelerating the company's global growth strategy.

In addition to serving as Chair of Dunwoody's Board of Trustees, Westling is a member of the board of directors of Bremer Financial Corporation (BFC). Bremer is a \$12 billion regional banking organization serving business and agricultural customers throughout Minnesota, North Dakota and Wisconsin. BFC is owned by the Otto Bremer Trust and BFC employees.
